



BADRANJBOYA

Leaf

The drug *Badranjboya* consists of dried leaves of *Nepeta hindostana* (Roth.) Haines (Lamiaceae); the plant is found in hilly parts of Punjab, Bengal, Bihar, Kumaon, Rajasthan, Deccan and Konkan. It occurs during winter season.

- **Temperament:** Hot 2° Dry 2°
- **Action(s):** Exhilarant (Mufarreh), Cardiotonic (Muqawwi-e-Qalb), Concoctive of black bile (Munzij-e-Sauda), Blood purifier (Musaffi-e-Dam), Resolvent of swelling/Anti-inflammatory (Mohallil-e-Waram), Calming agent (Musakkin)
- **Therapeutic Use(s):** Cardiac insufficiency(Zof-e-Qalb), Palpitation(Khafaqan), Epilepsy (Sara), Facial palsy(Laqwa), Hemiplegia(Falij), Polyarthrititis(Waja-ul-Mafasil)
- **Dose:** 5-7 g.
- **Important Formulation(s):** Majoon-e-Khader
