Exudate

The drug *Behroza* arala is an exudate obtained by tapping the wood of *Pinus roxburghii* Sargent (Pinaceae); a monoecious conifer found in north-western Himalayas at an altitude between 460 and 1400 m

- **Temperament:** Hot and Dry
- **Action(s):** Resolvent (Mohallil), Dryness producing agent in wounds (Mujaffif-e-Qurooh), Diuretic and Emmenagogue (Mudirr-e- Baul wa Haiz), Antiseptic (Dafi-e-Taffun)
- **Therapeutic Use(s):** Retention of urine and Amenorrhoea (Ehtibas-e-Baul wa Tams), Cervical Lymphadenopathy(Khanazeer), Gonorrhoea(Suzak).
- **Dose:** 2 – 4 g.
- **Important Formulation(s):** Marham-e-Jadwar, Marham-e-Zangar, Zimad Jalinoos,
